The University Cycle Forum gives an opportunity for staff and students to have an input into the continuing development of the University Transport Policy, and influence the setting of priorities for expenditure on cycling issues from Transport Policy Income. The Group is represented on the City Cycle Forum and therefore has direct input into the decision making process on cycling issues at a city-wide level.

The university is pleased to promote cycling as a sustainable alternative to the use of the private car. We are committed to reducing our environmental impacts and employ a dedicated Energy & Environment Team to promote energy conservation, smart transport choices, re-cycling and waste reduction.

### ***Training...***

We offer free cycle training to staff, and students can take advantage of free cycle training offered by Sheffield City Council. Even if you've cycled regularly in other parts of the country, you may find that Sheffield with its hills is quite different to cycle in, and a training session will get you off to a good start!

Training is provided by Pedal Ready who are fully qualified CTC cycle trainers

### ***Meetings...***

We hold meetings on key dates through the academic year, giving everyone a chance to have their say about cycling policies and facilities around the University. Meetings are at lunchtime and food is provided.

### ***Rides***

We hold a Wednesday Lunchtime ride during Teaching Semesters. Meet on the Concourse, 12:30 Rides last for an hour and are a great opportunity to discover University facilities and local cycle routes

### ***Maps***

The University is proud to publish its own Cycle Map. Copies are available at the Source in the Union building, or on request from the Energy & Environment Team.

### ***Cyclists MUSE Group***

The SU Cyclists MUSE group is the place to go for cycling news. By registering on the group you will be kept up to date with cycling events around the Uni and the City.

### ***Bike Week***

### ***Cycle to Work Initiative***

The Cycle to Work Initiative (CtWI) lets staff members pay for a bicycle and cycling safety accessories over a period of time, directly from their wages - and saves money in the process.

A Cyclists' Special leaves the Cathedral on the last Sunday of every month. Fare: £5 return for a cyclist and their bike (Tandems £10). Pay on the tram.
