Language and Communication Impairment in Children

Multi-professional courses focusing on children's language and communication difficulties and the impact of these on learning. For all who work with children with special educational needs in schools and in other contexts.

- **Advanced Certificate (UGrad Level)**

For teaching / learning support / SLT assistants and nursery nurses.

1 year, part-time by distance learning course. Continue to work whilst studying online.

- **MSc, PG Dip, or PG Cert**

For speech and language therapists, teachers and other professionals.

1 to 3 years, part-time by distance learning courses. Continue to work whilst studying online

Human Communication Sciences

An Inter-disciplinary course; Core and optional modules cover all aspects of speech, language and communication and research methodology.

- **MSc** (ESRC Recognised) Study full-time for 1 year or part-time for 2 years.

Speech Difficulties and Cleft Palate

A suite of programmes providing speech & language therapists and others with the opportunity to develop specialist knowledge and skills.

- **PG Cert in Cleft Palate Studies**

Part-time, 1 year course (block attendance) or study by distance learning.

- **MSc or PG Dip in Speech and Cleft (SPACL)**

Courses available full-time over one year; part-time for one to three years (block attendance) or study by distance learning.

- **MSc or PG Dip or PG Cert in Speech Difficulties**

Courses available full-time over 1 year; part-time for 1 to 3 years (block attendance) or by distance learning.

MPhil/PhD

- **Post-Graduate Research Degree**

Programme available, full-time or part-time. Supervision available for research across all aspects of speech, language and communication, including children or adults with communication impairments.
