MSc in Logistics and Supply Chain Management

MSc in Logistics and Supply Chain Management

This 12 month programme provides a multi-dimensional overview of how to manage and improve a global and international supply chain. You will learn how to effectively manage logistical operations and adopt the appropriate enabling technology and strategy to improve performance and create competitive advantage.

With European Trading Scheme (ETS), Carbon Reduction Commitment (CRC) and other regulatory requirements – as well as a political mood of green consumerism - driving the need to decarbonise the supply chain, major industry players are already planning for the future and adopting Radio Frequency Identification (RFID), Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) and Logistics Information System (LIS). This programme will examine the contribution these systems make and provide the skill-sets required to equip future leaders in the low carbon area.

Profile of typical candidate

To succeed and be competitive both now and in the future, managers need to understand how to manage and improve global and international supply chain performance. Green skills have been identified as a major gap by many governments and industry leaders. This programme equips future leaders with a skill-set in an important growth area.

Entry specification

A 2:1 honours degree, or approved professional qualification. You do not need prior management experience.

Our standard English requirement for overseas students is IELTS 7.0 (with no less than 6 in each part). If you are unable to take IELTS we will consider TOEFL 600 with TWE 4.5 (paper-based) or TOEFL 260, TWE 5.0 (computer-based) or equivalent.
