Aim

SCMIS2009 aims to gather leading experts in the spheres of supply chain management and information systems to share and exchange new ideas and innovation to shape the future direction of research and knowledge exchange in supply chain management and information systems.

The theme for SCMIS2009 is “Low Carbon and Green Supply Chain”. With increased pressure to respond to the effect of climate change, it is a global concern that many fragmented and disorganised operations and effort have been invested attempting to minimise carbon footprint and CO2 emission. SCMIS2009 will pull together some consensus from leading experts in related fields and formulate new directions, strategies and priority areas for the next 10 years.

Structure

Attendance at SCMIS2009 is by invitation. It is envisaged that this workshop will gather 20 leading experts from academic, industry and government in these fields to provide a highly intellectual, inspired, thought provoking and innovative knowledge sharing platform and important debate. Special Issue with high impact factor journals (SCI and SSCI etc) will also be organised to collate the leading thoughts and research on low carbon and green supply chain. Strategy paper will be prepared for selected governmental bodies.
