A new collaborative research initiative, the Catchment Science Centre (CSC), has been established jointly by The University of Sheffield and the Environment Agency.

The CSC conducts novel interdisciplinary science to support the sustainable management of freshwater ecosystems in both rural and urban environments.

Achieving sustainability will involve fundamental changes in the fields of river research and management, moving towards the vision of river basins as integrated socio-ecological systems.

The CSC promotes interdisciplinary research across multiple departments at Sheffield, and has strong links with academic and non-academic partners. Initial activities are supported by a £1M grant from the EC, funding the research of 12 Fellows in the CatSci programme within the CSC.
