Case Western Reserve University, founded in 1826, is one of the nation's leading independent research universities, with programs in the arts and sciences, engineering, medicine and health sciences, law, management, and social work. Baccalaureate, masters, and doctoral degrees are offered. We are located in University Circle, a 550 acre area of more than forty cultural, medical, educational, religious, and social service institutions at the eastern edge of Cleveland, Ohio. Our more than 4000 undergraduates enjoy the benefits of attending the world famous Cleveland Orchestra; visiting the Cleveland Museum of Art, which houses one of the country's finest art collections; or studying at the Cleveland Institute of Music or the Cleveland Institute of Art. A vibrant downtown scene featuring the Rock 'n Roll Hall of Fame, numerous museums, and waterfront activities complement University Circle.
