Financial requirement

Financial guarantee amount The Australian National University (ANU) has no specific financial requirement.

However, the Australian government requires student visa applicants to declare that they have enough money to support themselves whilst in Australia (at least £5,000 per year plus airfare).

Brief overview of the university

The Australian National University's Student Mobility Program (SMP) has been in operation for over 10 years. Visiting international students can combine academic study and a wealth of social and cultural opportunities over a period of one to two semesters. Pre-arrival information

Which is your nearest airport? Canberra Airport, however, students will probably arrive at either Sydney or Melbourne airport.

Do you offer an airport pick up programme? We have a meet and greet program from Canberra airport.

Brief details We have arranged for a shuttle bus from the airport. There will be one shuttle bus service per hour. The Meet and Greet Shuttle Bus is free of charge. If your parents or relatives are travelling with you, it is free for them as well. The shuttle bus will stop at various residential halls on the ANU Campus. The last stop will be the International Office at the Pauline Griffin Building. Here you can visit the welcome room, and we can help you call a taxi if necessary to take you to your off-campus

accommodation.

The ANU representatives at the Airport Welcome Desk will also be able to give you some more information about transportation. If you will live off-campus, it might be faster and cheaper to take a taxi from the airport directly to your accommodation.

The Meet and Greet Shuttle Bus will be available from Monday 5 July to Sunday 18 July, from 9 am to 5 pm*.

If you arrive outside of those times, you will need to arrange your own transportation to your accommodation. Please refer to our 'Arriving after hours' information below for more information about transport options, routes, times and costs.

The Meet and Greet Service must be arranged at least **one week** in advance (1 week before your arrival in Canberra)

Please note:

- On arrival at Melbourne or Sydney, allow **two hours** for Customs Clearance.
- Meet and Greet is a courtesy service. If you have more than two suitcases, you must inform us.

Health Insurance

Do you have mandatory health insurance?	Yes
Brief details	As an international student, it is a condition of your student visa (Condition 8501) that you have Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the

entire duration of your study in Australia. OSHC is a private health care arrangement, which helps cover the costs of medical treatments in and out of hospital, should you get sick or have an accident.

Worldcare is a preferred health cover provider of the Australian National University. However, this arrangement does not restrict you from obtaining OSHC from a provider of your choice. Please see the following links for further information:
