Brief overview of the university

Created by the Oklahoma Territorial Legislature in 1890, the University of Oklahoma is a doctoral degree-granting research university serving the educational, cultural, economic and health care needs of the state, region and nation. OU enrolls more than 31,000 students, has more than 2,000 full-time faculty members, and has 19 colleges offering 147 majors at the baccalaureate level, 152 majors at the master's level, and 80 at the doctoral level. The OU "Sooners" are also a sports powerhouse, consistently ranking in top 10 of all major college sports. Located in the city of Norman, OU is the state's flagship institution and has an active role in numerous aspects of the community. Some 1,700 international students attend OU, including exchange participants from more than 50 different countries.

Restricted/closed Departments	Aviation, Medical School, Law (only for students who are law majors at their home institution), Graduate Business coursework and Economics (undergrad and grad)
Can I pre-register for classes before arrival?	Yes, Students finalize their course schedule during the first two weeks of classes.
If yes, please give details	You submit a course preference sheet along with your exchange student application. The Study Abroad Office in Oklahoma then works to enroll you before you arrive in the U.S. Students are not allowed to enrol themselves before arrival but can change once they are on campus.
