Who can apply to IMPACT?

IMPACT is for young people who have the academic potential to succeed at the University of Sheffield but may feel uncertain about whether it is the right option for them. Students are selected by their school to become part of IMPACT if they meet the following criteria:

- Be the first generation in their immediate family to enter Higher Education
- Be from an area of low progression to university (your school can help you with this information)
