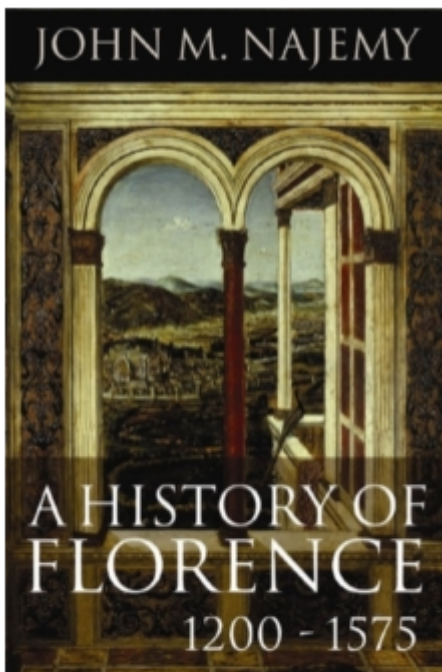




VLeBooks- eBook Accessibility


How do I change the text size?

- Load up the eBook in by selecting 'Read Online'.

- The online reader allows for 5 different zoom levels in addition to the browser's standard zoom functionality.
- To decrease or enlarge the text, click the plus or minus symbols in the top right corner.

NOTE: please wait for the page to load after clicking once.



- You can also change the text to 'Large font' by selecting 'Edit Accessibility setting' (See 'Other Accessibility settings below')

How do I change the background colour?



- The background colour of the page can be changed by clicking on the colour wheel icon in the top right corner.
- Clicking the icon multiple times will scroll through the 7 colours available.

Can I change the text colour?

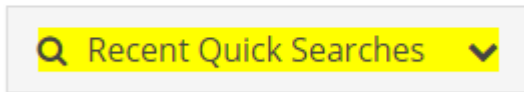

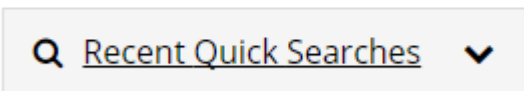
