Terms of Reference:

1. To advise the University on effective and efficient use of its education space, ensuring that sustainability is considered in all decisions and that student experience is maximised by:
 - (a) reviewing and develop policy and strategy;
 - (b) reviewing best practice in the sector;
 - (c) making recommendations for improvements and investments.
2. To advise the University on the maintenance and development of its education space, ensuring that student experience is maximised by:
 - (a) overseeing and reviewing the management of the University's education space in terms of functionality and utilisation;
 - (b) developing policy and strategy for future education space;
 - (c) utilising new ways of delivering education developed during the pandemic.
3. To advise the University on appropriate IT infrastructure requirements, improvements and investments in support of 1 and 2 above.
