ADVANCED SUPERVISOR WORKSHOPS

FOR SUPERVISORS OF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY TRAINEES

Running alongside the Initial Supervisor Workshop (ISW) training programme, a yearly series of Advanced Supervisor Workshops (ASW) is also organised. These represent one-day training events for more experienced supervisors and are free to attend. The workshops are organised by the Sheffield, Hull and Leeds programmes for supervisors in the Yorkshire and Humber Region. The topics for the events are generated by supervisors in the region and therefore change each year. Workshops may take place in Sheffield, Leeds or Hull, or at a central location where possible. We have found that all the training events have been very popular and there have been waiting lists to attend. So if you are interested in gaining a place please apply early.

These workshops are a means for supervisors who have had experience of supervising to continue to review and renew their training in supervision skills in line with the BPS accreditation of supervisory skills. From September 2016 it is a HCPC/BPS requirement, and therefore mandatory, for all supervisors to attend (as a minimum), one workshop in every 5 years as this ensures your eligibility to supervise clinical psychology trainees.
