Study Break Passes: It's important to take a break from studying from time to time. You can use these passes to leave you desk for up to 45 minutes.

StarPlus is the library catalogue, it will give you access to our online resources and show you where to find physical books and journals. StarPlus can be accessed by logging into **MUSE** > **My Services** > **StarPlus.** StarPlus will display the **shelfmark** of the item, and if it is available online.


Google Scholar can <u>link to our library resources</u>.


