How to Show Your Right to Work in the UK

You need to generate a share code to provide to the employer using the instructions here, if:

- Your current visa is granted on a Biometric Residence Permit (BRP)*;or
- You have been given a digital visa status for your current visa; or
- You have Settled or Pre-Settled Status under the EU Settlement Scheme

The employer will need to do a manual check on your documents using <u>these instructions</u> here, if:

• Your current visa is less than 6 months in length and is on a vignette (sticker) in your passport**.

Please note that you **do not** have the right to work in the UK if:

- You are a national of a country not listed in <u>Appendix V of the Immigration Rules</u>, you travelled to the UK without a visa and were given a stamp in your passport at the border showing you have entered the UK as a Visitor; or
- You are a national of an EU or EEA country, Australia, Canada, Japan, New Zealand, Singapore, South Korea or the USA who entered without obtaining a visa before travelling to the UK and you entered the UK using an e-gate

The employer will need to contact UKVI using the <u>Employer Checking Service</u> to confirm your right to work, if:

- You have submitted a visa application to UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) inside
 the UK (using the UKVI ID Check app or if you have attended or are attending an
 appointment at a UKVCAS centre to confirm your identity) and that application has
 still not been decided; or
- The employer is unable confirm your right to rent using any of the above methods

If the result of the checks shows that you either have a valid UK visa or a valid pending visa application that you submitted in time (before your visa expired) you will be considered to have the right to work in the UK

^{*}If you applied for your visa outside the UK and the visa is valid for longer than 6 months, you will be given a vignette (sticker) inside your passport to allow you to enter the UK. You will have a BRP issued to you and you will collect it after you arrive in the UK.

^{**}If you applied for your visa outside the UK, and the visa is valid for 6 months or less, your vignette (sticker) will be valid for the whole length of the visa you are granted.
