NIHR Clinical Lectureship – 2011

The NIHR Clinical Lectureships are specialty training posts that incorporate academic training. Clinical Lecturers (CLs) spend 50% of their time undertaking specialist clinical training and 50% undertaking research or educationalist training. CLs are aimed at those who are advanced in their specialty training, have completed a research doctorate or equivalent and show outstanding potential for continuing a career in academic medicine. The duration of a CL is for a maximum of 4 years or until CCT is reached, whichever is sooner. Alongside clinical training, CLs will be able to develop their academic skills and will be encouraged to apply for funding to support further postdoctoral or educationalist training. The 2011 NIHR Clinical Lectureship recruitment round is now open and will end on 31 March 2012. NIHR Invention for Innovation (i4i) - Challenge Awards

The i4i Challenge Awards is a new funding stream that aims to bridge the gap between the innovation and development of new medical technology and its adoption into clinical pathways. The first competition will address the diagnosis and monitoring of cardiovascular disease, which encompasses a range of diseases of the heart or blood vessels including coronary heart diseases such as angina and heart attack, stroke and peripheral arterial diseases such as thrombosis.

Research proposals are invited from project teams led by a clinician based in an NHS Trust, in cooperation with commercial and Higher Education Institution partners as appropriate. There is no formal limit on funding and projects will be funded up to 100 per cent of eligible costs, for up to three years.
