

Application for Alumni Research Award in Animal Sciences

This prize was established by two former APS students who have a passion for whole-animal biology and who would like to support promising potential researchers in this area. The aim is to support a gifted student in undertaking a summer research project or a practical course to learn techniques to broaden their experience and focus their ideas about whether or not they wish to pursue a research career.

Frequency of the award: One annually

Value of the award: £1000

Eligible candidates: Level 1 undergraduates on courses in Animal and Plant Sciences. Preference will be given to applicants who have achieved a minimum of 65% in practical based modules.

Assessors: Head of Department of Animal and Plant Sciences; Director of Teaching in APS; and at least one additional assessor at professorial level who will normally be an animal biologist.
