Question bank

Below is a set of questions that may be suitable to use with public audiences for public engagement events. Questions should be used or adapted to measure the extent to which the aims and objectives or the event have been achieved.

Respondents should be able to complete the evaluation anonymously and the inclusion of demographic and personal information should be optional and at the end. Personal data about gender, sexual orientation and ethnicity etc should only be requested when there is a definite justification for doing so. Do not collect data that is not useful or just in case it might be needed.
