



# UNIVERSITY HEALTH SERVICE - Type 1 Data Sharing Opt Out- Oct 2018

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The University Health Service may provide information to other organisations who use data for health planning, medical research and developing treatments. In all circumstances these will be NHS approved organisations. This includes (but is not limited to) organisations such as NHS Digital.

You can choose not to have information about you shared, or used, for any purposes other than your individual care. This is known as a Type 1 Opt Out.

### NHS Digital

Information about you is used in a number of ways by the NHS and social care services to support your personal care and to improve health and social care services for everyone. NHS Digital is the NHS organisation with a legal responsibility to collect data as people make use of NHS and social care services. The data is used locally and nationally to help with planning, managing your care, supporting research into new treatments, identifying trends and issues and so forth, and is used to try to make services better for all.

Please note if you are happy to share your information specifically with NHS Digital but unhappy for them to share your data with a further party you need to complete a Type 2 Opt Out. To make a Type 2 Opt Out you must apply via: <https://www.nhs.uk/your-nhs-data-matters/>
