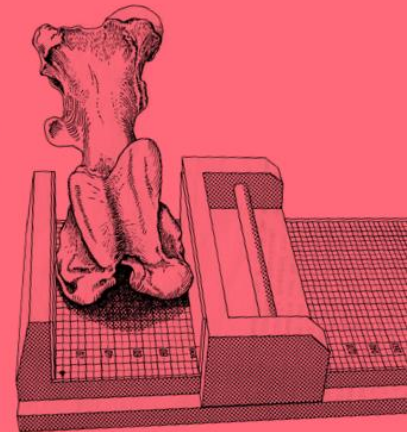


UNDERSTANDING ZOOARCHAEOLOGY II
